CAM MUTUAL AID Brother's Keeper Grants

Purpose

To provide assistance to individuals who <u>experience hardship</u> due to losses incurred that are excluded losses for resharing according to the CAM Mutual Aid Guidelines. Also included are instances where the individual may be responsible for injury/damage done to other persons or other persons property.

Funding

CAM will make a contribution to the Brother's Keeper Grant Fund in the amount of 1.5% of the assessments received annually. If a major catastrophe occurs and funds are needed to pay for property claims, funds may be withdrawn from the Brother's Keeper Fund immediately to pay for claims.

Eligibility

Brother's Keeper Grants are only available to CAM Mutual Aid members for activities, incidents, or losses pertaining to primary property.

How does it work?

Brother's Keeper Grant Applications are reviewed on a monthly basis. Grants are given based on need and available funds.

How do you apply for a grant?

A Brother's Keeper Grant Application must be submitted to the CAM Office. The application requires a detailed description of the need, signatures verifying the need and hardship from the member's pastor, deacon, or elder and the member's CAM representative. Any applicable receipts or estimates should be included with the application.

Approval for Grants

All applications must be approved by the CAM Executive Committee in order to receive a Brother's Keeper Fund Grant.
